<u>4Canoes</u> is a Canadian based content creator and publisher formed in response to the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Calls To Action. 4Canoes content is evolving as a unique, ongoing, 28-edition series created to bring Indigenous Peoples telling their stories into our classrooms and homes. Each issue highlights a different Indigenous Peoples, and is produced with integrity and respect. The 4Canoes team embeds and works with the featured People for months, providing a forum for them to tell their stories.

Service Summary

- Subscribe to access an ongoing 28 edition series, collection of children's books, OWL Special

- Each edition and children's book builds awareness about Indigenous culture by sharing the stories as told by the People about the land, water, and culture
- Subscriptions are available annually and can be canceled at any time
